Directions

Start outside the Ardler Complex and turn to your left. Walk along Turnberry Avenue until you reach Gleneagles Lane, there will be a small pond to your right. Walk to the end of this road and turn left onto Gleneagles Road. At the end of Gleneagles Road turn right onto Gleneagles Avenue. Follow this road all the way round to Turnberry Avenue. You will see a large pond on your right. Turn left and walk back to the Ardler Complex along Turnberry Avenue.

Points of interest

- Look out for swans and ducks.
- The swales and ponds in Ardler are part of a sustainable Urban Drainage System - designed to manage surface water and provide a habitat for wildlife.
