Screening Determination under Section 8(1)

Section 8 (1) of the Environmental Assessment (Scotland) Act 2005 requires Local Authorities to determine if a plan is likely to have significant environmental effects.

Dundee City Council has determined, in consultation with the Scottish Environment Protection Agency, NatureScot and Historic Scotland, that the introduction of a Low Emission Zone in Dundee is likely to have significant effects and that a strategic environmental assessment is required. An Environmental Report will therefore be prepared and will identify, describe and evaluate the likely significant effects on the environment of implementing a Low Emission Zone in the city.
