

# Welcome to Camperdown Country Park

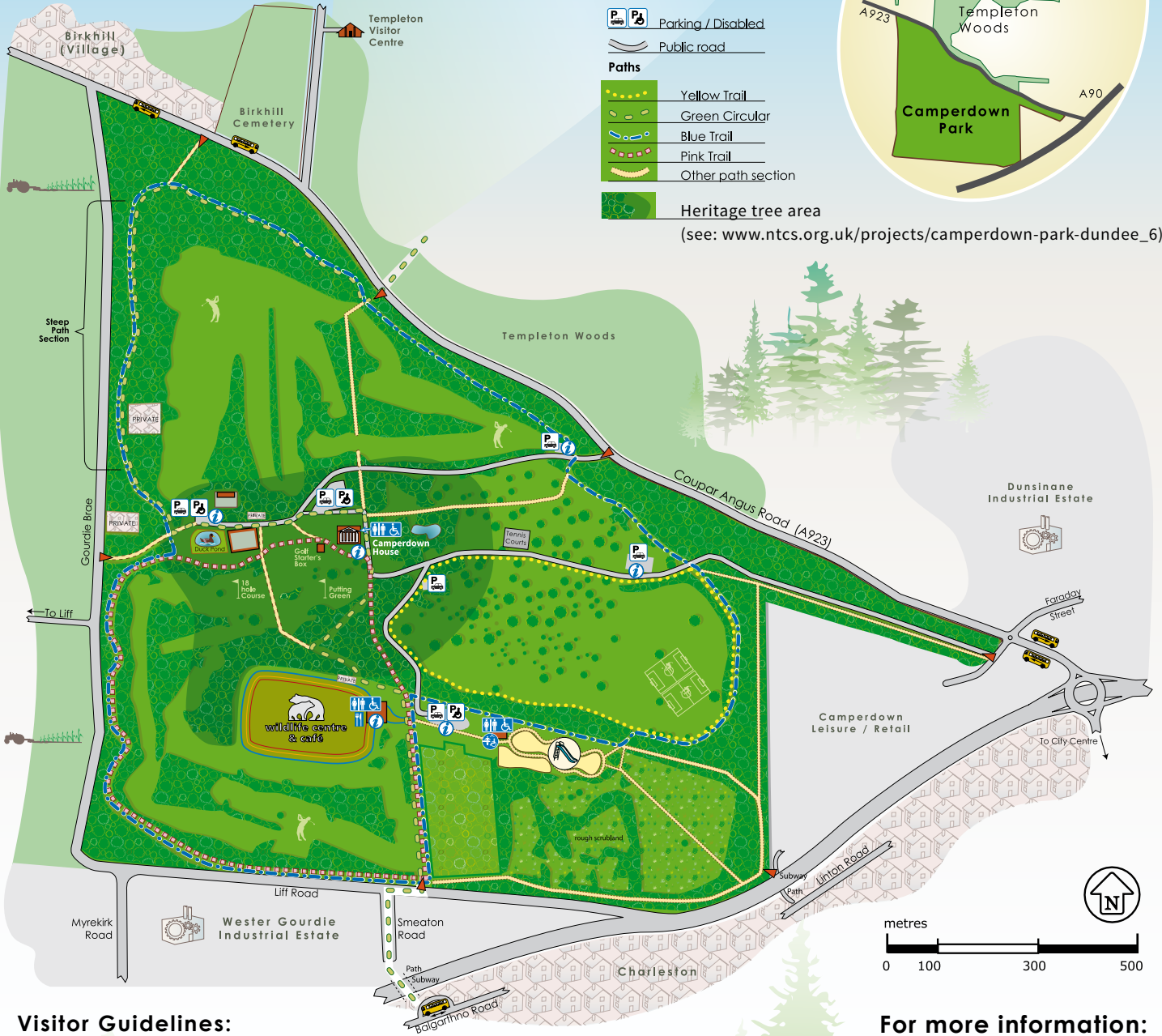
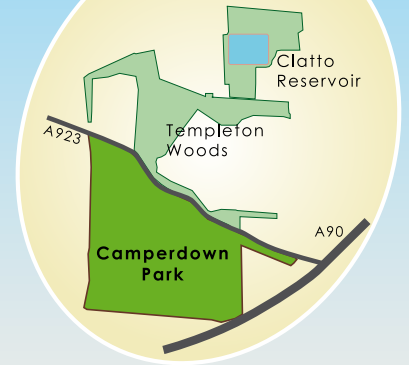
Camperdown Park is a former estate purchased for the people of Dundee in 1945. At 400 acres, it is the largest park in Dundee and contains two golf courses, a wildlife centre, a large play complex and many other interesting features to discover.

## Visitor Guidelines:

Please be responsible, follow these simple guidelines and show consideration for other visitors to this park.

Please see main management rules for details.

1. **Fires are not permitted.** (Contained BBQs OK).
2. **Cars are not permitted off paved areas unless specifically directed.**
3. **Consumption of alcohol in the park is an offence.**  
(The Dundee City Council Prohibition of Consumption of Alcohol in Designated Public Places Byelaw 1999)
4. **Cyclists: please act responsibly to other park users.**
5. **Golf / golf practice is only permitted in designated areas of Camperdown Park.**
6. **Dogs must be under close control or on a short lead at all times.**
7. **Dog Waste is a Health Hazard:**  
**NOT** cleaning up your dog's mess is an offence. (The Dog Fouling (Scotland) Act 2003)
8. **Littering and dog fouling are punishable by instant fines.**
