

THE DEER AMENDMENT (SCOTLAND) ACT 1982 VENISON DEALER'S CONDITIONS

- 1. Venison for sale shall be stored at the holder's premises specified in the licence and shall be made available for inspection by an authorised officer of the City Council or any police constable.
- 2. Records of purchases and receipts of venison must be maintained in the form prescribed by the Licensing of Venison Dealers (Prescribed Forms Etc) (Scotland) Order 1984. A copy of the prescribed form is attached. Records must be available for inspection by any person authorised by the Secretary of State for Scotland, the Red Deer Commission, or by a police constable.
- 3. This licence may be surrendered to the City Council at any time whereupon it shall cease to have effect.
- 4. This licence must be delivered to the City Council:
 - (a) within seven days after a decision of a Court disqualifying the holder from holding or obtaining a licence;

or

(b) if the holder ceases to deal in venison.
