

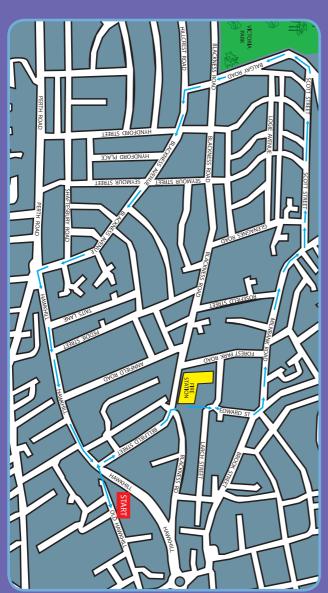
Hawkhill Hike

Directions



Start outside the Institute of Sport and Exercise on Old Hawkhill. Walk up Old Hawkhill and cross over Hawkhill at the traffic lights. After crossing the road, continue past the Whitehall Theatre on Bellfield Street, At the end of Bellfield Street, cross over Blackness Road and walk along the path to the right of the Fire Station, this will take you to Larch Street. Keep walking ahead and down Edward Street. At the end of Edward Street turn left and walk up Milnbank Road. Turn left onto Scott Street and continue up to Balgay Park. Walk into the park and turn left and take the path down the side of Victoria Park. The path exits the Park on the corner of Balgay Road and Blackness Road. Cross over Blackness Road and continue down Balgay Road. Follow the road round to the left and walk down Blackness Avenue until you get to Hawkhill. Turn left onto Hawkhill and walk back towards the university buildings until you reach the start point.

Points of interest

- Views of the Tay from Blackness Avenue.
- The name 'Hawkhill' refers to the original hunting area.
- The Edward Street Mill was built in 1851 as part of the Logie Works and has the oldest complete power loom factory in the city.
- Look out for the ceramic panels by Keith Donnelly on Bellfield Street.
