

**10      CIVIC GOVERNMENT (SCOTLAND) ACT 1982 - PROPOSED NEW STREET NAMES  
(AN111-2003)**

The Committee is asked to approve the undernoted street names:

Brook Court	Logie	Brook Street to the south	To keep links with the existing street name
Wurzburg Loan	Ninewells	Tom McDonald Avenue to the north	The previous new road in this area was given the name Wurzburg to associate our links with the twinned city. This will continue that association.
Hazlehead Avenue, Hazlehead Street, Hazlehead Lane	Ardler	Ardler 3C - Turnberry Avenue Rosemount Road	To continue the naming strategy for Ardler Village ie golf courses

As discussed at the Planning and Transportation Committee on 27th January, 2003 it has been agreed with the developer that the proposed street name of Amond Place will be changed to Amond Way.

There was a deferment of an item from the Planning and Transportation Committee on 27th January, 2003 for the new street names associated with the development at Brackens Road to allow the developer to express a preference as to the spelling of the street name. The developer has stated that they would prefer to see the English spelling of the name i.e. Rannochmoor Gardens. It is therefore proposed to allocate this name to the new street. The gaelic spelling of the name Rhoineach Mhor will however be included on the bottom of the street name plate in a smaller font.

The Committee is asked to approve accordingly.
