

4 NATIONAL CYCLE NETWORK ROUTE 1 AND 77 WINTER MAINTENANCE (AN12-2022)

Further to the Policy and Resource Committee held on 26th April, 2021 (Report 133-2021), Article VIII of the minute of the meeting refers. Officers have reviewed the provision of cycleway winter maintenance and identified additional revenue funding to allow Tayside Contracts to carry this out in future on the 15km length of National Cycle Network Routes 1 and 77 within Dundee City Council's boundaries. Adjoining Local Authorities have been advised of Dundee City Council's service provision to allow for consideration of service on the National Cycle Network outwith Dundee.

The additional costs associated with the service provision are an estimated annual revenue cost of £39,690 for route treatments with a reoccurring annual inflationary uplift and £24,586 for one-off upgrades to adapt the route by removing vehicle barriers. These costs will be provided for within the City Development Revenue Budget from 2022/2023. The plant and equipment related to this service will be procured by Tayside Contracts.

The Committee is asked to approve the provision of winter maintenance to the National Cycle Network Route 1 and 77.
