11 DUNDEE CITY COUNCIL (HIGH STREET AND REFORM STREET, DUNDEE) (EXEMPTION FOR WEDDING VEHICLES) ORDER 2001 (AN132-2002)

Reference is made to Article XXII of the minute of meeting of the Planning and Transportation Committee of 25th June, 2001 instructing and authorising the preparation of an Order to enable vehicles carrying wedding parties to wedding ceremonies in the City Chambers to gain access to High Street and exit via Reform Street.

The proposed Order was duly drafted and during the statutory consultation an objection was received from the Chief Constable. However, on 25th March, 2002 the Planning and Transportation Committee authorised publication of the Order as drafted.

The Order was duly advertised and there were no further objections. The objection received from the Chief Constable has not been withdrawn.

The Committee are requested to make the Order as advertised despite the objection (as per Agenda note for 25th March, 2002). The Council do not require to hold a hearing in regard to the objection although it may do so if they consider it appropriate.
