12 ANTI SOCIAL BEHAVIOUR OFFICERS FORUM (ASBOF) - ANNUAL SUBSCRIPTION (AN375-2003)

The Anti Social Behaviour Officers Forum (ASBOF) was founded in 2000 with the aim to bring together local authority officers who have a responsibility for operational and strategic responses to anti social behaviour.

ASBOF is now recognised as being representative of the views of practitioners and is regularly consulted by Scottish Executive, COSLA and professional bodies such as the Chartered Institute of Housing.

The Forum is an important source of information on good practice on anti social behaviour responses within the local authority sector and it is recommended that the Council continues to participate in ASBOF and to that end pay the annual subscription fee of £250 which allows it two representatives at the regular Forum meetings and access to an extensive database of good practice.
