

3 COX'S STACK OPEN SPACE – PEDESTRIAN ACCESS (AN412-2003)

The public open space around Cox's Stack is owned by Dundee City Council (excluding the chimney stack). The open space was landscaped at the expense of the developer of Stack Park with access off Methven Street. The adjacent factor of the High Mill flats in the former Camperdown Works due to trespass problems has closed off the former pedestrian access from the south of the site.

The Committee is asked to approve the construction of a new pedestrian access to the open space from Eastwell Road at an estimated cost of £9,000 subject to landowner's consent. It is recommended that the work be carried out by Dundee Contract Services and met from the provision of £50,000 in Dundee Contract Services 2003/04 Capital Budget for Public Open Space Improvements.
