

4 CONTRACT FOR TREATMENT OF PAPER AND CARD (AN58-2019)

Following the expiration of the existing contract for the sorting and onward recycling of all mixed paper and card collected by Dundee City Council, it was necessary to undertake a procurement exercise to secure a contractor to accept this material from September 2019.

The invitation to tender for this service was issued by way of a mini competition via the Scotland Excel Dynamic Purchasing System on 12th July 2019. Following the tender closing date of 26th July and the subsequent evaluation of bids, it is recommended that the contract be awarded to:

Wyllie Recycling Ltd

The total value of the contract for the duration of the 2 year specified period plus the optional 2 year extension is anticipated to be approximately £148,114 based on the specified fixed cost/rebate per tonne and projected tonnage over this period. These costs will be contained within the Neighbourhood Services Revenue Budget.

Bids were evaluated on the rebate/cost per tonne including the haulage costs to the bidders depot.

The table below demonstrates that Wyllie Recycling Ltd were the most economically advantageous bidder to the Council, and approval is now sought to award this contract.
