4 DAWSON PARK - ENVIRONMENTAL IMPROVEMENTS (AN79-2012)

As part of a programme of improvements to Dawson Park, it is proposed:

- to erect a fence between the car park at the Dunnottar Place entrance and the park to reduce damage to the grass areas caused by indiscriminate parking and vehicle turning; and
- to extend the existing footpath network to connect to the play area.

It is proposed to refurbish and re-use an existing fence recovered from the site clearance at Allan Street Car Park. The cost of undertaking these works will be £6,555 and the Director of Corporate Services advises that these costs can be met from allowances within the Environment Department's Capital Budget 2012/13.

It is recommended that the proposed improvements are approved and that the Director of Environment be instructed to undertake these works.
