6 COAST PROTECTION ACT 1949 - DOUGLAS TERRACE WALKWAY IMPROVEMENT (AN85-2007)

The Coast Protection Act 1949 prohibits the excavation or removal of material from the seashore where a coast protection authority has made an Order under Section 18 of the Act prohibiting such operations. Under the terms of the Act, when an order is in place the Coast Protection Authority may grant a license to any person wishing to carry out such works. Dundee City Council is the Coast Protection Authority for the foreshore from Stannergate to the City boundary at Barnhill and an Order under Section 18 of the Act is in force.

Tenders for the above works were approved at Planning and Transportation Committee on 8 January 2007. The works are being promoted by Dundee City Council and planning consent for the works has been given. Works include limited excavation of material from the seashore which will be controlled to avoid any impact.

The Council is unable to grant itself a license therefore the Committee is asked as Coast Protection Authority to approve the works within the seashore as outlined.
