1 PURPOSE OF REPORT

1.1 This report considers the necessity to stop-up the two lay-bys situated on the north side of Kinnoull Road utilising the powers of the Town & Country Planning (Scotland) Act 1997.

2.1 It is recommended that the Committee approve the preparation of a Stopping-Up Order to stop-up the two lay-bys on the north side of Kinnoull Road between Kinnoull Street and Broomhill Road to accommodate a new development following planning consent.
