### 1 PURPOSE OF REPORT

1.1 This report considers the necessity to stop-up and remove from the List of Public Roads lengths of carriageway and associated footways at the west end of Luna Place, Dundee utilising the powers of the Town & Country Planning (Scotland) Act 1997 following planning consent.

# 2 RECOMMENDATION

2.1 It is recommended that Committee approve the preparation of the necessary Stopping Up Order to stopup and remove these sections of carriageway and footway from the List of Public Roads.

#### 3 FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

3.1 The costs of preparing the Order will be met by the developer.

### 4 BACKGROUND

- 4.1 Following planning approval it will be necessary to stop-up and remove from the List of Public Roads lengths of carriageway and associated footways which will be contained within a site with a new fence line. The lengths depicted on the available plan will require to be stopped up.

- 4.3 The length of roads, footways and footpaths on the attached plan will require to be stopped up and removed from the List of Public Roads.
