1 PURPOSE OF REPORT

1.1 This report considers the requirement to provide and alter waiting restrictions in the vicinities of the new Dundee Railway and V&A developments.

2 RECOMMENDATION

2.1 It is recommended that the Committee approve the preparation of a Traffic Regulation Variation Order to affect the changes to the waiting restrictions in the relevant Traffic Regulation Orders for Dundee.

3 FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

3.1 It is proposed that the total cost of implementing these proposals, estimated at £2,000, be met from within the City Development Car Park Trading Account. An additional £750 is required in annual maintenance costs for signing and lining and this will also be met from within the City Development Department's Car Park Trading Account.

4 BACKGROUND

4.1 It is proposed to vary the undernoted Traffic Regulation Orders for the reasons listed. All drawings have been made available at the following web link:

 - 1 Greenmarket (Railway Station Access Road) (See Drawing No 1) West End Ward
 - It is proposed to introduce waiting restrictions to service Dundee Railway Station.
 - 2 Riverside Drive (See Drawing No 1) West End Ward

It is proposed to introduce loading only bays servicing the new V&A and rail station developments.

b Dundee City Council (Car Club & Electric Vehicle Parking Places) Order 2015

1 Greenmarket (Railway Station Access Road) (See Drawing No 1) – West End Ward

It is proposed to introduce 2 Electric Vehicle Charging bays at Dundee Railway Station.

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c Dundee City Council (Disabled Persons Parking Places) (On Street) Order 2011

1 Greenmarket (Railway Station Access Road) (See Drawing No 1) – West End Ward

It is proposed to introduce 2 Electric Vehicle Charging bays at Dundee Railway Station.

d The Tayside Region (Marketgait, Dundee) (Clearway) Order 1983

1 Riverside Drive (See Drawing No 1) – West End Ward

It is proposed to adjust the existing clearway order to exempt the proposed loading bay on Riverside Drive adjacent to the V&A development.
