4.0 MAIN TEXT

Counter-fraud performance and comparison data for the previous year is detailed on the attached appendix and the main highlights are summarised below.

- Total amount of overpayments identified by the team for the year 2014/15 is £1,891,420.00. This is the highest the team has ever achieved.
- The Fraud Team continue to increase their non-benefit fraud cases and the total of corporate savings identified for the year 2014/2015 is £232,301.00
- The amount of referrals that the team received this year has risen by 41% compared to the previous year. Much of this due to the team receiving Corporate Fraud referrals

The local authority will also endeavour to recover in full, from the claimant, the overpaid benefit.
