1 PURPOSE OF REPORT

1.1 This report considers the request to review parking in Dundee West End to remove unnecessary lining which could be utilised by the residents who struggle to find unrestricted areas close to their property.

2 RECOMMENDATION

2.1 It is recommended that the Committee approve the preparation of a Traffic Regulation Variation Order to affect the changes to the waiting restrictions in the relevant Traffic Regulation Orders for Dundee.

3 FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

3.1 It is proposed that the total cost of implementing these proposals estimated at £4,000 be met from within the City Development Car Park Trading Account.

4 BACKGROUND

4.1 It is proposed to vary the undernoted Traffic Regulation Orders for the reasons listed. All drawings have been made available at the following web link:

i <u>Edward Street/Larch Street/Blackness Road/Rosefield Street/Glenagnes Road/Abbotsford Street/Perth Road/Roseangle/Seafield Road/Bellefield Avenue/Magdalen Yard Road (See Drawing Nos 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14) - West End Ward</u>

It is proposed to reduce unnecessarily severe lengths of "At Any Time" restrictions.

ii Roseangle (See Drawing No 11) - West End Ward

It is proposed to convert a short length of "no daytime waiting" to an "at any time" restriction to protect a vehicle access.

iii Blackness Road (See Drawing No 3) - West End Ward

It is proposed that a bus stop be removed and replaced within a "buses and taxis only" restriction a short distance away to free up an area for unrestricted parking.

iv Perth Road (See Drawing No 7) - West End Ward

It is proposed to extend an existing taxi rank which will help the taxi trade at this West End location.
