1.0 PURPOSE

1.1 To authorise the purchase of eight vehicles as part of the 2006 rolling replacement programme.

2.0 RECOMMENDATIONS

2.1 It is recommended that the committee accept the price of the undernoted, which would be procured via the ABC pricing framework.

3.0 FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

3.1 The total cost of the vehicles is estimated at £570,000. This can be met from the Waste Management Department's 2006/07 Capital Budget.

6.0 MAIN TEXT

6.1 The vehicle types specified are within the categories of the ABC framework agreement which the City Council subscribed to in June 2005. Purchasing these vehicles from this source as opposed to supply from normal dealer networks has provided an estimated total saving of £20,000.
