4 BACKGROUND

- 4.1 The Boundary Commission for Scotland are tasked by the Parliamentary Constituencies Act 1986 to undertake a review of Westminster Parliament Constituencies in Scotland.
- 4.2 The Commission published their Initial Proposals in October 2016 and a Public Hearing on the proposals was held in Dundee on 29th November, 2016. A copy of the Summary of the Initial Proposals has been issued separately to all Elected Members for background information. The proposals for the Angus Glens and Dundee East Constituency and Dundee Constituency can be found on pages 13 and 24 respectively.
- 4.3 The Public Consultation on the Initial Proposals closes on 11th January, 2017 and the City Council's instructions are requested regarding the Council's response.
