1 PURPOSE OF REPORT

1.1 This report details tenders received and seeks approval on acceptance thereof.

2 RECOMMENDATION

2.1 It is recommended that Committee approve the acceptance of the tender submitted by the undernoted contractor as set out in the report, with the total amount, detailed in Appendix 1.

3 SUMMARY OF PROJECT TENDERED

3.1 A preferred bidder has been identified by the City Promotions Events Team in relation to the projects detailed below.

3.2 The works comprise the creation and supply of suitable content, infrastructure and staff to deliver a Christmas visual display installation on the front of City Chambers.

3.3 Each visual show will last for approx. 5 minutes played every half hour, from 5.00pm to 8.30pm on weeknights and from 3.00pm to 8.30pm on Saturdays and Sundays and from 3.00pm to 4.00pm on Christmas Eve from approximately 2 December through to 24 December 2021. Times to be confirmed in agreement with City Chambers staff.

3.4 The visual display should fill the front of the central panel of the building, above the pillars but will not require to be mapped exactly to the space.

3.5 The visual display artwork will have an accompanying soundscape and have playful elements for the public lasting approximately 4 to 5 minutes long. DCC are working in partnership with Beano Studios and will have some vectored artwork available to include.

3.6 The PA requirement is for a medium sound output, audible in City Square but in order to be good neighbours, not overly impacting the city centre. Sound levels and impact will be monitored to ensure no adverse effects.

4 FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

4.1 Funding for the above project is available through existing City Development revenue budget.

5 BACKGROUND PAPERS

5.1 Detailed information relating to the tender is included on the attached appendix. To ensure Best Value, the works in this report have been procured using the general guidance contained in the following documents approved by the Council:
