5.1 The recommendations in the schedule have been made after an access audit carried out using the Scope/Disability Rights Commission access checklist.

#### 6.0 BACKGROUND

- 6.1 Polling districts and places are reviewed immediately prior to an election, with the last review taking place in early 2001. Elections to the Scottish Parliament and local elections on 1st May, 2003 have prompted this review.
- 6.2 Following normal practice a consultation exercise was carried out in July/August 2002 and wherever possible the views of elected members have been included in the recommendations.
- 6.3 Every polling station has been visited and an access audit as approved by Scope and the Disability Rights Commission has been carried out. The audit comprised car parking, access to the building, ramps, door widths, lighting etc.
- 6.4 Two polling places do not fully comply with access requirements however, there are no alternative premises available locally.
- 6.5 Those polling districts prefixed ACA to ACE are within the Angus constituency and the Angus constituency Returning Officer has designated the polling places concerned.
- 6.6 Those polling places marked thus \* are being used as a polling place in more than one ward.

7.1 All elected members have been consulted as have the Directors whose departmental buildings are being used.

Two changes are recommended:-

1. As regards Eastern Primary access to the school should be taken by the entrance in the playground to the rear of the building which is currently only used for disabled access. This avoids the use of any stairs and also complies with the Scope recommendations regarding access.

2. As regards Grove Academy currently polling takes place in the dining hall with access by a fire exit. This entrance does not comply with the access requirements and the hall is not big enough. It is therefore proposed to use the gym as the polling station. This hall is larger and the access is compliant with the Scope recommendations. Carpeting/matting will be used to protect the floor, if necessary.

- 2. It is proposed that WBP be combined with WAU. This would mean that these electors would vote at Mill O' Mains Primary.
