1 PURPOSE OF REPORT

1.1 This report considers the necessity to stop-up various lengths of footpaths and roads and also to delete them from the list of roads within Foggyley and Beechwood utilising the powers of The Roads (Scotland) Act 1984.

2 RECOMMENDATION

- 2.1 It is recommended that the Committee approves the preparation of a Stopping-Up Order under the powers of The Roads (Scotland) Act 1984 to stop-up lengths of footpaths and roads in the Foggyley Gardens area of Dundee as they will no longer be necessary following the demolition of multi-storey residential blocks. Access for statutory undertakers will be maintained for their plant.
- 2.2 The Committee is also asked to approve the preparation of a Stopping-Up Order under the powers of The Roads (Scotland) Act 1984 to stop up lengths of footpaths and roads in the Balshando Place, Hatton Place and Lundie Place areas of Beachwood as they are no longer necessary following the demolition of flatted residential properties some years ago.

3 FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

3.1 The costs of preparing the Order will be met by the Estates Regeneration Fund.

4 BACKGROUND

- 4.1 Following the demolition of the housing in Foggyley Gardens, Balshando Place, Hatton Place and Lundie Place the remaining lengths of road no longer serve any properties. In order for any future development to take place, it would be necessary to remove these lengths of road, footway and footpaths.
- 4.2 The lengths of footpaths and roads which are depicted on the attached plans will require to be stopped-up and removed from the list of roads.

5 POLICY IMPLICATIONS

5.1 This Report has been screened for any policy implications in respect of Sustainability, Strategic Environmental Assessment, Anti-Poverty, Equality Impact Assessment and Risk Management.

There are no major issues.
