The range of proposed measures include building energy control optimisation, LED lighting upgrades, solar photovoltaic roof panels, modifications to heating, ventilation and cooling systems, pipework insulation and combined heat and power. The Council properties involved are Olympia Leisure Centre, Dundee Ice Arena, Central Library, The Crescent, Unit T,Claverhouse, Dundee International Sports Centre, McManus Galleries and Gellatly Street Car Park. The Investment Grade Proposal constitutes an energy efficiency construction programme with guaranteed energy savings. Given an expenditure limit of £1.601 million, the contractor has guaranteed energy savings of a value of £222,282 per annum. This equates to 20% of the baseline energy cost for the 8 properties giving a simple payback period of 7.2 years. This also
