### 1 PURPOSE OF REPORT

1.1 To include new off-street car parks for disabled holders in the Dundee City Council (Off-street Car Parks) Order 1996 for the purpose of enforcement and control.

### 2 RECOMMENDATION

2.1 It is recommended that the Committee approve the preparation of the necessary Traffic Regulation Order to include new off-street car parks at Bonnethill, Dallfield, Hilltown and Tulloch Courts for disabled badge holders as indicated on the attached plan in the Dundee City Council (Off-street Car Parks) Order 1996 for the purpose of enforcement and control.

#### 3 FINANCIAL IMPLICATION

3.1 The costs of promoting the Order will be met from the Better Neighbourhood Services Fund.

## 4 LOCAL AGENDA 21 IMPLICATIONS

4.1 The traffic management measures will provide a safer environment by providing dedicated parking spaces for the disabled off-street.

## 5 EQUAL OPPORTUNITIES IMPLICATIONS

5.1 These facilities will help in the creation of a barrier free city.

# 6 BACKGROUND

- 6.1 The Hilltown Terrace area suffers from intensive city centre commuter parking.
- 6.2 Although disabled badge holders can park on yellow lines they are not allowed to cause an obstruction. The Fire Brigade requested no loading at any time restrictions on much of the lengths of the access roads to Bonnethill, Dallfield, Hilltown and Tulloch Courts because parking by disabled badge holders obstructed access to their appliances.
- 6.3 In order to overcome this parking shortage, new off-street car parks specifically for disabled badge holders are being created at each of the multi-storey blocks. It is therefore necessary to include them in the off-street car parks order so that any abuse can be dealt with efficiently.

# 7 CONSULTATIONS

7.1 The Chief Executive, Depute Chief Executive (Support Services), Depute Chief Executive (Finance) and Assistant Chief Executive (Community Planning) have been consulted and are in agreement with the contents of this report.
