1.0 PURPOSE OF THE REPORT

1.1 This report details the recommendations of the Director of Social Work on the level of payments for services provided by voluntary organisations for 2005/2006.

2.0 RECOMMENDATIONS

It is recommended that The Social Work Committee: -

- 2.1 Agrees payments to the voluntary organisations listed in Appendix 1 at the levels outlined, subject to the Director of Social Work remaining satisfied that the service provided meets the service specification.
- 2.2 Agrees that Ardler Information Point be paid £23,650 for 2005/06, but that in accordance with paragraph 6.4 the organisation be advised to seek alternative sources of funding from 1 April 2006.

3.0 FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

3.1 The cost of implementing the recommendations within this report is £2,005,270. This cost can be met from the total 2005/2006 budget provision for payments to voluntary organisations.

6.0 MAIN TEXT

- 6.1 A range of voluntary organisations receive funding from the Social Work Department, as payments for services provided. The provision of these services is governed by a service level agreement with the organisation concerned.
- 6.2 The organisations listed in Appendix 1 all have service level agreements with the Social Work Department. The specification and monitoring requirements for these organizations are stringent, and as a minimum each agreement will be

reassessed each year to determine the appropriate level of funding for the next year. For most organizations, an inflationary increase of 1.25% is proposed for 2005/2006.

- 6.3 A rolling programme of detailed reviews is underway. These examine the content of service level agreements, the level of funding and the appropriateness of varying funding cycles, eg, to move to 3-year budgets. Where a review results in a recommended significant change in funding, a separate report will be brought forward to the Committee.
- 6.4 The Social Work Department has for a number of years supported Ardler Information Point. However, the work undertaken by this organisation is not related to core Social Work Services. It is therefore proposed that the Director of Social Work inform this group that funding from the Social Work Department will cease from 1 April 2006. This will give Ardler Information Point time to seek alternative funding.

7.1 The Chief Executive, Depute Chief Executive (Finance) and the Depute Chief Executive (Support Services) have been consulted in the preparation of this report.
