#### 1 PURPOSE OF REPORT

1.1 This report details proposals for energy efficiency works to Fleming Trust properties as part of the ongoing plan to install external wall insulation to suitable properties across Dundee and requests a decision on acceptance thereof.

#### 4 BACKGROUND

4.1 This project comprises a total of 92 properties owned by the Fleming Trust.

Fleming Gardens North 5, 8, 9,10,11,15, 20, 22. Fleming Gardens South 4, 8,10,14.

- 4.2 The project is expected to start by the end of April 2021 and will take approximately 23 weeks.
- 4.3 There are no owner occupiers in these properties therefore there will be no external funding through the Home Energy Efficiency Programme for Scotland Area Based Schemes (HEEPS: ABS) from the Scottish Government or the Energy Company Obligation (ECO) funding from utility companies.
- 4.4 The Contractors for these works have been procured by SSE Energy Solutions Ltd who are project managing the programme on behalf of the Council.
