1 PURPOSE OF REPORT

- 1.1 This report considers a request for alterations to waiting restrictions in William Fitzgerald Way due to inconsiderate parking on a blind bend which obstructs vehicular sightlines.

2 RECOMMENDATION

- 2.1 It is recommended that the Committee approve the preparation of a Traffic Regulation Variation Order to affect the changes to the waiting restrictions in the relevant Traffic Regulation Order for Dundee.

3 FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

- 3.1 It is proposed that the total cost of implementing these proposals estimated at £400 to be met from within the City Development Car Park Trading Account. An additional £125 is required in annual maintenance costs for signing and lining and this will also be met from within the City Development Department's Car Park Trading Account.

The Dundee City Council (North-Eastern Area, Dundee) (Waiting and Loading Restrictions) Order 2012

- William Fitzgerald Way (See Drawing 1) - North East Ward

Due to inconsiderate parking on a blind bend/close to a junction, it will be necessary to introduce waiting restrictions in order to prevent the likelihood of head-on collisions.
