6.0 BACKGROUND

6.1 Children generally require licences from the City Council before taking

part in performances in Dundee.

In terms of the 1963 Act a licence is not however required if the performance is given under arrangements made by a body of persons approved by the local authority in whose area the performance takes place. The Dundee Gang Show, Thomson Leng Youth Music Theatre, Downfield Musical Society and the Dorwin Stage School have already been approved for these purposes.

6.2 The Council have received two requests for approval:

(i) Dundee Operatic Society

The Dundee Operatic Society is a well-established amateur musical organisation. The Society holds parental consent forms in respect of all child members of the Society.

(ii) Dundee Junior Showtime

Dundee Junior Showtime is a well-established amateur children's Theatre Group. The Group holds parental consent forms in respect of all child members of the Society.

In the circumstances it is felt appropriate to approve the Dundee Operatic Society and Dundee Junior Showtime, the effect of which will be that no licences will be required for children to take part in their performances in Dundee.
