**REPORT ON: PENSION FUND - UPGRADE OF PENSIONS
ADMINISTRATION SYSTEM**

1 PURPOSE OF REPORT

1.1 To submit to the Committee a request for the upgrading of the AXISe pensions administration computer system to Altair.

2 RECOMMENDATIONS

2.1 That the Committee approves the upgrade of the AXISe computer system to Altair at an initial cost of £103,243 and an ongoing cost of £10,500 per annum.

3 FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

3.1 The cost of the upgrade will be charged to the Tayside Superannuation Fund.

4 BACKGROUND

4.1 Since 1994 the Pensions Section has been a member of the Computerised Local Authority Superannuation System (CLASS) consortium. There are currently over 90 local authorities who are CLASS members and the advantage of this is that the cost of amending the system is shared between the CLASS members.

4.2 Heywood Ltd are the software suppliers for CLASS and the product currently in use is the AXISe system. However, they have developed and recently released their next generation system, Altair. At present they are supporting both the AXISe system and the Altair system. Whilst there is currently no pressure to take the new system it is expected that some point in the future support will be scaled down on the AXISe system.

4.3 The upgrade offers a number of important benefits over the current system:

4.3.1 Browser technology improves ease of use

4.3.2 Users will be able to navigate the system quicker and it will be easier to train new users.

4.3.3 It includes a workflow system which will assist with the Section's work allocation and management to improve efficiency and facilitate flexible working arrangements.

4.3.4 The growing trend of concurrent employments is better catered for.

4.3.5 Altair is fully compliant with all legislation, including meeting e-government requirements.

4.4 Heywood Ltd have a workflow system called Task Management which is an add on to the AXISe system but is part of the standard Altair package. It has

been agreed with them that if a contract is signed for Altair, delivery would not be expected until late 2009. However, Task Management could be purchased for immediate use and the cost would be refunded from the cost of Altair. This would enable the Pensions Section to set up the workflow system prior to setting up Altair. Assurances have been given that Task Management will transfer over to Altair's workflow system seamlessly.

5 **POLICY IMPLICATIONS**

This report has been screened for any policy implications in respect of Sustainability, Strategic Environmental Assessment, Anti-Poverty, Equality Impact Assessment and Risk Management.
