1 PURPOSE OF REPORT

- 1.1 To seek Committee approval for the implementation of a Traffic Regulation Order to revoke a current one-way traffic restriction in Yeaman Shore.

2 RECOMMENDATION

- 2.1 It is recommended that the Committee approve the preparation of the necessary Traffic Regulation Order to revoke the current one-way traffic restriction which exists in an easterly direction in Yeaman Shore.

3 FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

- 3.1 The costs of preparing the Order will be met by The City Growth Fund.

4 BACKGROUND

- 4.1 To allow for the redevelopment of Dundee Central Waterfront, it is necessary that the current one-way Traffic Regulation Order in Yeaman Shore is revoked in order to allow the approved Waterfront Masterplan to be implemented.

- 4.3 In light of the above proposals, Yeaman shore will become a two-way carriageway. The Road Safety Audit procedures will ensure that safety of all users is considered at the design stage. Dundee City Council will ensure that the traffic changes are well publicised.
