6 MAIN TEXT

- 6.1 At its meeting of 18 June 2001, the Policy and Resources Committee approved the formation of a new department of Leisure and Arts, with the transfer of certain Grounds Maintenance and related works being transferred to Dundee Contract Services.
- 6.2 Grounds Maintenance throughout the Council, except for parks and cemeteries, is now carried out by the Parks Section of Dundee Contract Services.
- 6.3 The name Parks Section is causing confusion with the Parks and Outdoor Leisure Section of the Leisure and Arts Department, which is responsible for parks and cemeteries.
- 6.4 It is, therefore, proposed that the Parks Section of Dundee Contract Services be renamed Land Services. This will require certain posts at Dundee Contract Services to be redesignated as follows:-
 - Parks Manager to become Land Services Manager
 - Operations Manager (Parks) to become Land Services Operations Manager
 - Assistant Operations Manager (Parks) to become Assistant Land Services Operations Manager
 - Parks Supervisors (7) to become Land Services Supervisors
