### 6.0 BACKGROUND

6.1 The start of Session 2001/2002 was agreed by Dundee City Council Education Committee on 18 October 1999 (Article IV refers).
6.2 The scheme proposes a school Session of 195 days for teaching staff and 190 for pupils.
6.3 In-service days for teaching staff will be 13 August, 8 \& 9 November 2001, 24 May 2002 and 1 day in February/March 2002 allocated by secondary school cluster.
6.4 The proposed spring holiday includes Good Friday 2002 (29 March) and Easter Monday 2002 (1 April).
6.5 The proposed autumn fortnight is in accordance with established practice and includes the autumn holiday week.
6.6 Christmas Day falls on a Tuesday. This means schools will close on Friday 21 December and re-open for the spring term on Monday 7 January 2002.

### 7.0 CONSULTATION

7.1 This report has been the subject of consultation with the Director of Personnel \& Management Services, Director of Support Services, Director of Finance, Teacher Associations, Head Teacher Organisations and the Directors of Education in Angus, Fife and Perth \& Kinross Councils.
