## 6 BACKGROUND

## 6.1 Dangerous Building Notices

The City Engineer investigated 7 incidents relating to public safety of dangerous buildings during the month of August 2003. One formal Notice and Order were issued under Section 13(1c) of the Building (Scotland) Act 1959.

6.1.1 Mr Falconer 29 Benvie Road Dundee - Section 13 Notice of Intention to make Order requiring Operation on a Dangerous Building Order issued 15 August 2003. No appeal has been received.

## 6.2 Direct Action Taken

Direct action has been taken in one instance to ensure public safety is maintained under Section 13(1b) of the Building (Scotland) Act 1959.

6.2.1 <u>45, 47, 49 Commercial Street</u> - Fallen lead flashing from roof level. DCS inspected and secured remainder of flashing.
