1.0 PURPOSE OF REPORT

1.1 This report seeks approval to accept the offer for the supply of a specialist minibus for Kingspark School.

2.0 RECOMMENDATIONS

2.1 It is recommended that the Education Committee award the purchase of a specialist minibus for Kingspark School, procured via the Scotland Excel - vehicle framework, to Kerr & Smith, Glasgow, for the amount of £37,706.

3.0 FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

3.1 The Director of Finance has stated that this expenditure can be met from the Education Capital Budget in 2010-11.

4.0 MAIN TEXT

4.1 The purchase of the specialist minibus is to replace a vehicle which is beyond economical repair. Kerr & Smith have submitted an offer for the supply of an Iveco Daily 50C15 16-seater minibus, with specialist conversion complete with wheelchair fittings, etc. for the amount of £37,706.
