- 6.2 A grant application has been received from the proprietors of 101 Albert Street, a hairdressing establishment. This property is located within the targeted area.
- 6.3 The proposal is to introduce a contemporary shopfront, which has the benefit of planning permission, replacing the existing dowdy shopfront.
