### 1.0 PURPOSE OF REPORT

1.1. This report seeks approval for the demolition of the fire damaged cottages at Strathmore Avenue.

# 2.0 **RECOMMENDATIONS**

- 2.1. Approval is recommended of;
  - (a) the demolition of the cottages at Strathmore Avenue damaged in a recent fire.
  - (b) the City Architectural Services Officer, in conjunction with the City Engineer, being authorised to negotiate a contract not exceeding £20,000 (inclusive of an allowance for professional fees) under a partnering arrangement with an appropriate contractor and the Director of Support Services, in conjunction with the Director of Social Work, to accept the offer recommended by the City Architectural Services Officer.

#### 3.0 FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

3.1. The Director of Finance has stated that the cost of the works can be met from the Social Work Department's Capital Budget for 2002/2003.

## 6.0 **REPORT**

- 6.1. The cottages at Strathmore Avenue sustained damage in a recent fire and the occupants have been moved to alternative accommodation. The vacant, fire damaged property will be prone to vandalism and demolition of the property is recommended.
- 6.2 It is proposed that the City Architectural Services Officer enters into a partnering arrangement with an appropriate contractor to complete the demolition work within the allowance of £20,000.
