1 PURPOSE OF REPORT

1.1 This report considers the implications of introducing waiting restrictions in a new lay-by in South Marketgait to create a dropping off point.

2.1 The Committee is asked to approve the preparation of the necessary Traffic Regulation Order to introduce no waiting at any time restrictions in the new lay-by in South Marketgait which will be formed as part of the hotel development south of Nethergate. This restriction will allow for dropping off and picking up at the hotel.

6 BACKGROUND

- As part of the construction of a new hotel on the southwest corner of the junction of South Marketgait and Nethergate a lay-by will be provided south of the junction.
- This lay-by is being provided to allow guests and their luggage to be dropped off or picked up close to the hotel entrance.
- 6.3 In order to protect this function it is recommended that no waiting at any time be introduced over the entire length of the lay-by.
