1.0 PURPOSE OF REPORT

1.1 To authorise leasing arrangements for 1 recycling collection vehicle for use at the Environmental and Consumer Protection Department DSO.

2.0 RECOMMENDATIONS

2.1 It is recommended that the committee accept the offer from Terberg Matec UK at a total cost of £90775 (highlighted in the attached summary).

3.0 FINANCIAL IMPLICATIONS

- 3.1 The collection vehicle will be leased for a period of six years at an estimated annual rental of £16560.
- Provision will require to be made in the DSO Revenue Estimates for financial year 2002/2003 and subsequent financial years in respect of this expenditure.

4.0 DUNDEE 21 IMPLICATIONS

- 4.1 Health is protected by creating a safe clean pleasant environment.
- 4.2 Pollution is limited to levels with which the natural systems can cope.

5.0 EQUAL OPPORTUNITIES IMPLICATIONS

5.1 Under Local Government Act 1988, suppliers were required to complete and return a questionnaire to ensure that their business complies fully with the Race Relations Act 1976. All companies listed comply fully with the Act.

6.0 MAIN TEXT

- 6.1 The Environmental and Consumer Protection Department collect glass separately for recycling. The vehicle currently in use is 9 years old, beyond economic repair and is due for replacement.
- Dundee City Council went out to tender in November 2001 to seek the best and most cost effective vehicle type. Attached is a summary of the tender returns.
- 6.3 Although this is not the lowest offer, the vehicle body recommended (Terberg) is a more robust version of the type that has been successfully in service for 9 years. The price tendered however does compare well with the other offers. The chassis type is compatible with the other 23 tonne vehicles in the fleet, which have proved to give very good service and helps standardise stocks of spares and servicing.
