#### 6.0 ESTIMATED ADDITIONAL EXPENDITURE

- Reference is made to Article IV of the minute of the meeting of the Education Committee held on 30<sup>th</sup> June, 2003 when expenditure of £130,000 was approved in respect of boiler replacements at Blackness Primary School and Bellfield Nursery and authority was granted to negotiate partnering contracts with appropriate contractors.
- Subsequently, Taylor Mechanical Services were appointed to carry out the work at Blackness Primary School at an overall cost of £98,379. Within the reported cost of £98,379 an allowance of £6,000 was made for the inspection of the chimney and the removal of asbestos. The inspection of the chimney revealed that renewal of the cope and repairs to the underlying stonework was required. The removal of asbestos was also more than originally envisaged and the incoming gas supply also required upgrading. The additional cost of these works is in the region of £18,000 inclusive of an allowance for professional services.
