A report on behalf of Neighbourhood Services and City Development to the Committee to provide feedback of the results of consultation with regards to potential design options for Dundee's Low Emission Zone (LEZ). The report also seeks approval to submit the proposed response to a consultation by Transport Scotland entitled 'Scotland's Low Emission Zones: Consultation on Regulations and Guidance'. The approval to make a slight amendment to the objectives agreed previously by Committee for Dundee's LEZ in light of a late amendment included in the Transport (Scotland) Act 2019 is also sought. The report also provides an update to the Committee on recent developments in respect of the use of Traffic Regulation Conditions and funding support from the Scottish Government.

Intended Outcome:

Approval obtained to submit on behalf of the Council the response included at Appendix 3 of the report to the Transport Scotland consultation entitled 'Scotland's Low Emission Zones: Consultation on Regulations and Guidance. Also agreement given to make the amendment to the objectives for Dundee's LEZ as stated at Section 6.4 of this report, and approval for the delegation to the Executive Directors of Neighbourhood Services and City Development to commit to use the grant funding allocated to Dundee City Council as outlined in section 8.2 of the report to aid progression with the development of the Dundee LEZ.

How will the proposal be monitored?:

A further report to Committee will be presented in due course in respect to the ongoing development of the Low Emission Zone for Dundee. A detailed Integrated Impact Assessment will be undertaken for the future report to Committee when approval of the final design of the Low Emission Zone is being sought.


