A report to provide an update on the Councils Air Quality Action Plan and to summarise the results of the most recent full years (2019) monitoring data, an update work undertaken by Neighbourhood Services and City Development on the development of a Low Emission Zone (LEZ) for Dundee and confirmation of the 2020-21 Programme for Government commitment for the revised introduction date for LEZ's in Scotland, and to provide a briefing on the impact of COVID-19 on local air pollutant levels in Dundee during the lock down period between 23 March to 31 August 2020.

Intended Outcome:

Approval to remit the Executive Director of Neighbourhood Services to continue to take forward the Council's Air Quality Action Plan (AQAP) measures, continue to work with the Scottish Government and its partners with the Cleaner Air for Scotland (CAFS) strategy and it's review, and to submit the 2020 Air Quality Annual Progress Report to the Scottish Government and the Scottish Environmental Protection Agency. Also, approval for delegated authority to be given to the Executive Directors of Neighbourhood Services and City Development to utilise grant funding allocated to Dundee City Council by the Scottish Government and Transport Scotland to aid progression with measures contained within the Air Quality Action Plan and the development of the Dundee LEZ.

How will the proposal be monitored?:

Further reports to Committee will be presented during the process to develop Dundee's Low Emission Zone. A further Integrated Impact Assessment will also be undertaken for the future report to Committee when approval of the final design of the Low Emission Zone is being sought.


