ABOUT MARYFIELD

Maryfield Ward includes that part of the city that lies between the Tay and the Kingsway taking in the docks, City Centre and the wider Stobswell and Maryfield areas. Over 17,000 people live in the Ward in a variety of housing types but tenements dominate. The City Square, the main shopping district, the Howff and MacMannus Galleries are distinct to the Ward but shared with the rest of the City.

Maryfield houses Scotland's smallest University: Abertay with the other major educational establishment being Morgan Academy. This district building is a key feature of the north of the Ward with Baxter Park, Swannie Ponds, the Forfar Road Transport Depot and the Maryfield Hospital site as close neighbours. The last of these houses Dundee's International Sports Centre (DISC). This area with other sites make parts of Maryfield remarkable green given its largely inner-city nature. Smaller shopping areas including Albert Street add to the mixture of housing, workplace, open space and culture attractions. Arthurstone Library, the Old Steeple, the Shore youth centre and a number of places of worship are amongst the areas obvious sites of historical interest. These sit alongside the wards regenerated jute mills and the working area of the riverfront.

LOCAL COMMUNITY PLANNING PARTNERSHIP

The Maryfield Local Community Planning Partnership meets each quarter. It enables Council Department's to work together better with partner agencies at a local level. The aim is to deliver services and activities in a way which better meets the needs of people in Maryfield.

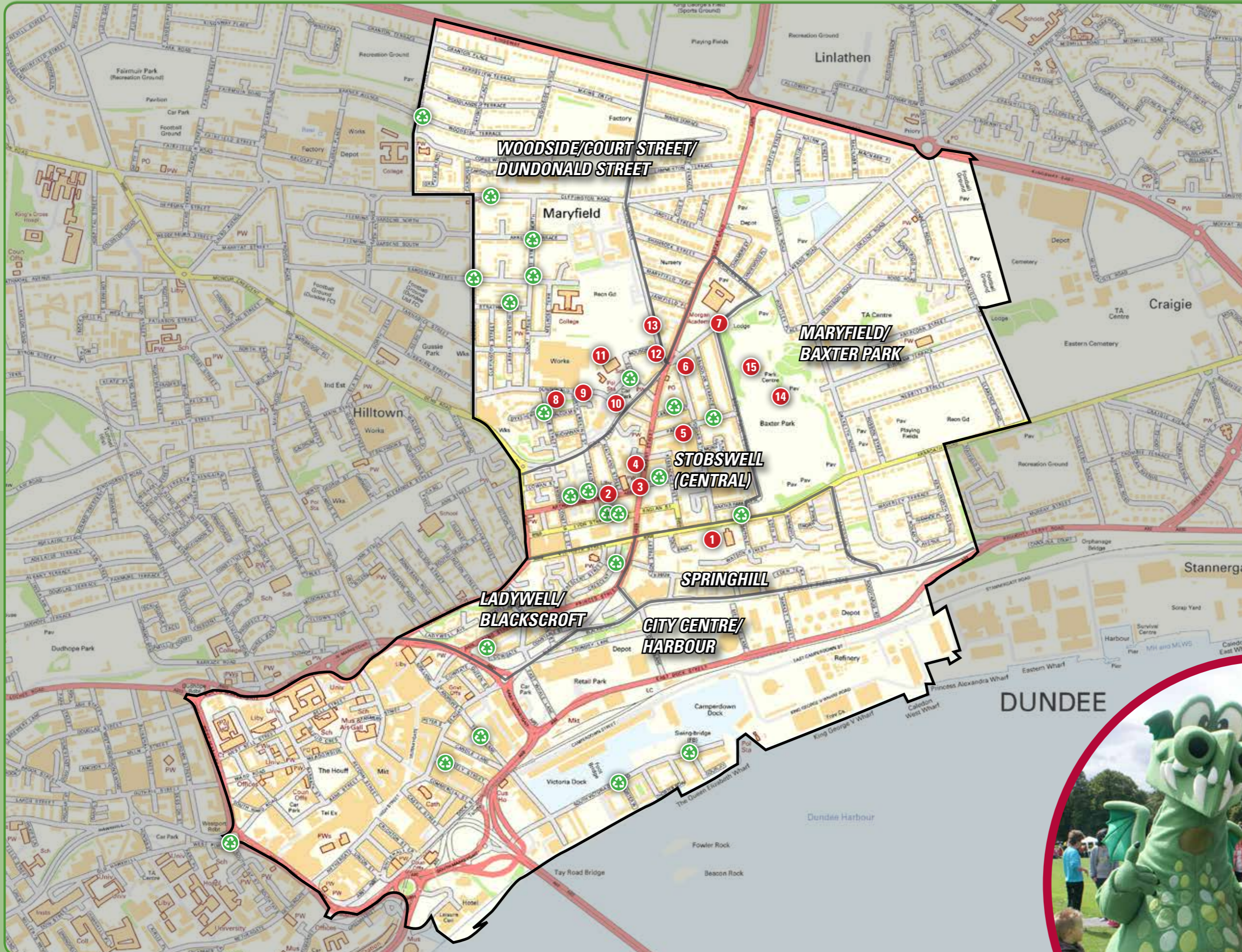
The Partnership meeting is chaired by Dundee City Council Head of Information Technology and is regularly attended by all three local elected members, senior staff from other key City Council Departments and planning partners including the Voluntary Sector, Police Scotland, Scottish Fire and Rescue Service and NHS Tayside. Community representation at the Partnership is drawn from local community organisations.
