

## TAXI TESTING

Taxi testing has currently been suspended for a period of 12 weeks as a result of the Coronavirus Pandemic.

In the meantime, the Clerk to the Licensing Committee advises the Taxi Trade as follows.

If a vehicle has a plate, it can continue to be operated provided it is properly maintained and kept safe to drive (that is, kept in a roadworthy condition) and has an MOT or extended MOT. (Drivers should also ensure that they take appropriate infection control measures to keep both themselves and their passengers safe.)

All other vehicles should not be operated until they are tested.

In view of the timescales involved this note was approved by David Martin, Chief Executive in consultation with the Convener of Dundee Licensing Committee, Labour Group Spokesperson, Conservative Group Spokesperson, Liberal Democrat Group Spokesperson, the Independent Member and the Lord Provost.
