Works in Relation to Trees

As part of the Planning Legislation, land owners are required to seek written consent from the Planning Authority to carry out works to trees within their garden ground if their properties are within a Conservation Area or covered by a Tree Preservation Order. We received a total of 24 enquiries/requests.

There are a further 3 sites which are presently having Tree Preservation Orders being prepared and served.
