

7 ROAD HUMPS (SCOTLAND) REGULATIONS 1998 - HIGH STREET LOCHEE, DUNDEE (AN201-2009)

Reference is made to the minute of meeting of this Committee of 28th June, 2009, wherein the Committee approved the introduction of traffic calming and speed tables in High Street, Lochee. Traffic calming is a key element to the regeneration of the High Street and is central to the successful Town Centre Regeneration Fund bid. The £2 million awarded by the Scottish Government is conditional on the works being completed by 31st March, 2010 and therefore it is critical that works commence on site by October 2009.

During the statutory consultation and public notice period nine comments/letters of objection plus one petition were received. Copy correspondence has been sent to Group Leaders, the Lord Provost and Depute Lord Provost. The petition plus four letters of objection were in respect of the proposed direction of the one-way traffic flow and are therefore not relevant to the introduction of traffic calming and speed tables.

The Committee is therefore requested to authorise the scheme for the introduction of traffic calming and speed tables in High Street, Lochee.
