## 10 EDUCATION DEPARTMENT - NATIONAL PRIORITIES ACTION FUND - TRANSITIONAL ARRANGEMENTS 2002/2003 - STAFFING (AN249-2002)

The above report was referred to the Education Committee, with the staffing implications being remitted to the Personnel and Management Services Committee. The report advised that with the exception of additional teachers for reducing class sizes and classroom assistants the majority of posts attached to Excellence Funded Initiatives have been employed for many years on extended temporary contracts. It is, therefore, proposed that the undernoted key posts be established on a permanent basis. The Committee is asked to approve the establishment of the undernoted posts:-
