

10 CONFIRMATION OF TREE PRESERVATION ORDER - GROUND TO THE EAST OF KINGS CROSS ROAD, DUNDEE (AN296-2005)

Members are asked to note on 16th March, 2005 the Council made a provisional Tree Preservation Order covering a further 6 trees at the above mentioned site. Members are also asked to note that these trees were omitted from the original Tree Preservation Order 01/2005 that was made in relation to this site in January of this year. These Tree Preservation Orders were made in response to the owner proceeding to implement an expired planning consent. At that time it was unclear from the survey if these 6 additional trees were contained within the boundaries of the site. A further inspection by the Council's Forestry Officer has confirmed these trees are within the boundaries and so the Council considered these trees also merited protection due to their arboreal and visual amenity.

Members are asked to authorise the Depute Chief Executive (Support Services) and the Director of Planning and Transportation to undertake the necessary procedures and confirm the above Tree Preservation Order.
