

4 DUNDEE COMMUNITY SAFETY PARTNERSHIP – DIVERSIONARY YOUTH ACTIVITIES (AGES 12-16 YEARS) – SUMMER 2004 (AN363-2004)

With reference to Article IV of the minute of meeting of 16th August, 2004, the Committee is asked to note the successful programme of summer youth initiatives (11 in total) targeted at young people and externally financed with support from the Scottish Executive. In accordance with Award conditions, a monitoring and evaluation report has been completed and submitted to the Scottish Executive.

Key outputs/outcomes include:

- 1550 participants involved
- 221 sessions of activity offered
- 667 hours of tuition delivered
- 105 different activities offered
- Motor crime, vandalism and youth nuisance calls all reduced
