

1 AREA TOURISM PARTNERSHIP – REPRESENTATION (AN368-2005)

The Angus and Dundee Area Tourist board ceased to exist earlier this year as part of the tourism review carried out by the Scottish Executive. Tourism support services are now the direct responsibility of Visit Scotland and are partially carried out via local "hub" mechanisms.

Area Tourism Partnerships are now being set up to provide local input to area tourism strategy and service provision.

Provision has been made for the City Council to be represented by two elected members and one officer.

It is proposed that Mr Grant Anderson, Policy Manager, Economic Development Department be appointed to serve on the Partnership and instructions are requested with regard to elected member representation.
